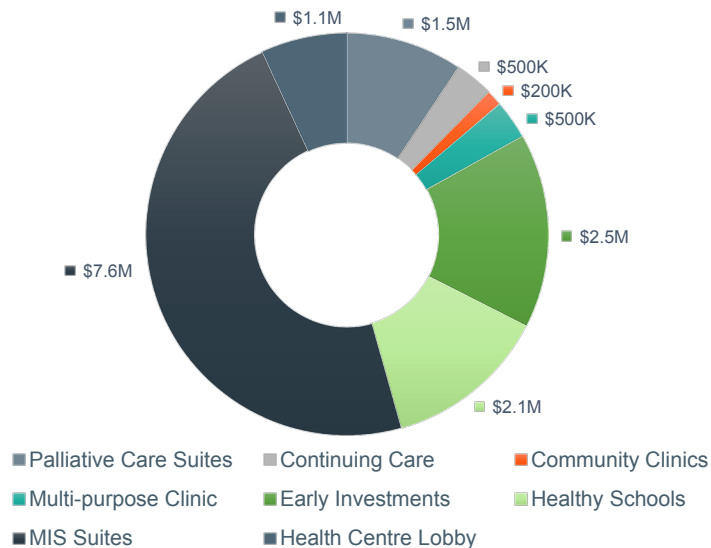


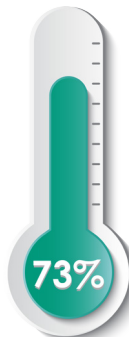

\$4.0 million

Thanks to you, we have now raised \$4.0 million or **53%** of our goal towards the **Minimally Invasive Surgical Suites**. These

suites are not only the largest project within the campaign, they will have a significant impact on the lives of residents.

Currently, there are approximately **265** surgeries performed each month at the Northern Lights Regional Health Centre. With **MIS** technology, even more surgeries can be done here, saving out-of-town travel, stress, and costs. We will all have access to the highest quality surgical care, right here at home.

The benefits of **MIS** technology for the region include:

Surgery close to home means the possibility of no travel & recovery close to loved ones	Laparoscopic surgery results in better cosmetic results & improved surgical outcomes
Getting back to regular life and work activities in days or weeks rather than months	Ability for AHS to recruit additional surgeons to the region and improve hospital efficiency

We are \$3.6 million from our goal and with your continued support, we will bring this innovative technology to benefit all residents of Wood Buffalo.

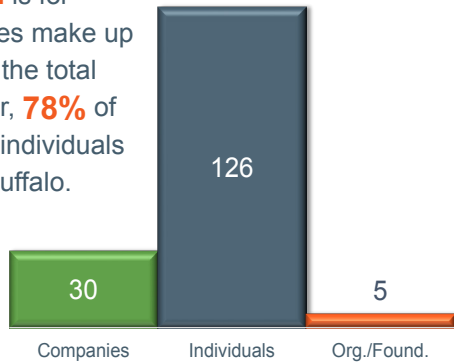

- 1 Multi-Purpose Clinic Fully Funded**
Bouchier Group and David & Nicole Bouchier have been involved from the onset of the Campaign. With a generous donation, they demonstrate their leadership and commitment to health care and the community.
- 2 Community Clinic Renovations complete**
Industry leaders Nexen Energy ULC and Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. funded the Public Health Community Clinics in Anzac and Conklin while contributing to the entire campaign and bettering health care in the region. Clinic renovations are complete.
- 3 Continuing Care Renovations fully funded**
Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. funded 100% of the Continuing Care project, creating a comfortable and nurturing space for continuing care clients to call home while they receive ongoing care and treatment.
- 4 Palliative Care Suites fully funded**
Thanks to the generosity of businesses, individuals and Jeremy Snook Memorial Raffle ticket purchasers, this project is fully funded. On March 31, 2017 an MOU was signed with AHS allocating funding for the construction of the 3 new Palliative Care Suites in the Northern Lights Health Centre.
- 5 Public Health Initiatives supported**
Following the 2016 wildfire, AHS saw the urgency in providing the Early Investments and Healthy Schools programs to the community. Recognizing the need, AHS immediately provided the resources to fulfill these important initiatives.
- 6 Minimally Invasive Surgical Suites**
Syncrude Canada Ltd., Lead Donor of the Minimally Invasive Surgical (MIS) Suites Project, gives the project a giant leap forward with a \$2 million dollar donation.
